Unvaccinated PK-12 Student, Teacher or Staff member identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 (August 19, 2021)

The Ontario County Department of Public Health will issue a Quarantine Order



Individual is symptom free for 10 days from their last contact with the COVID-19 case.

AND


Individual is released from quarantine by the Ontario County Public Health.



Individual can return to school.

While in quarantine, individual has a temperature >100° OR has symptoms of COVID-19 that are new or unusual for the individual.

- Fever, chills
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Cough
- Nasal congestion
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches





COVID-19 test result is negative*: Individual remains in quarantine for the remainder of the 10 days.



COVID-19 test result is positive*: Individual is placed in Isolation for 10 days from start of symptoms by OCPH.



Individual does not get a

COVID- 19 test: Individual

remains in quarantine for 10

days.





Individual is released from Quarantine or Isolation by OCPH.
INDIVIDUAL CAN RETURN TO SCHOOL.

PreK-12 student, teacher, or staff member with proof of full vaccination is exposed to COVID-19. (August 19, 2021)



Individual has no symptoms.



Individual can remain in school if no symptoms develop,

AND

Individual wears a mask indoors for 14 days from date of exposure per CDC guidance.

Highly recommended: PCR COVID test **3-5 days** after exposure per CDC guidance. *



Individual develops a temperature >100° OR COVID-19 symptoms (new or unusual to individual):

- Fever, chills
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Cough
- Nasal congestion
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches



Individual is placed in Isolation by OCPH pending PCR COVID test result.





COVID-19 test result is positive or NO test is done: Individual remains in Isolation per OCPH.



COVID-19 test result is negative: Individual may return to school

after discussion with OCPH and if school district's requirements for return are met.

Individual is released from Isolation by OCPH on day 11 if fever-free x 24 hrs. and symptoms have improved. INDIVIDUAL CAN RETURN TO SCHOOL.

Student, Teacher or Staff member with <u>NO</u> <u>Known Exposure</u> has a temperature >100° OR exhibits new or unusual symptoms of COVID-19:

Fever, chills • Shortness of breath • Sore throat • Loss of taste or smell • Headache • Loss of appetite • Cough • Nasal congestion • Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea • Fatigue • Muscle or body aches



REGARDLESS of vaccination status, individual must stay or return home.

Contact health care provider.



Alternate diagnosis

Individual can return to school with a note signed by their health care provider explaining the alternate diagnosis.



COVID-19 test result is negative*:

Individuals can return to school if symptoms are improving, and they are fever-free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication.

They must provide a copy of the negative test result or a note from their health care provider indicating the negative result.



COVID-19 test result is positive:

Individual is placed in isolation by OCPH.

Individual can return to school after being released from Isolation by OCPH.



No test/No alternate diagnosis:

Individual may return to school after at least 10 days have passed since date of first symptoms

AND
Individual's
symptoms are
improving
AND

Individual is fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medicines.

It is school responsibility to follow-up/monitor these individuals
