

2020 Black Scholars Recognized by Urban League

The following seniors were honored by the Urban League of Rochester's 41st Annual Salute to Black Scholars. The program, which identifies Black Scholars from school districts in Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Orleans and Wayne Counties, provides recognition, assistance, and incentives to students who achieve and maintain a "B" or better average throughout high school.

Congratulations to the following VSHS students, and best wishes on all of your future academic pursuits!

In 1980, the SALUTE TO **BLACK SCHOLARS was** founded by the Urban League of Rochester to recognize outstanding academic achievement among graduating Black high school students. That first year, 56 graduates of Rochester and Monroe County high schools were honored. In the 40 years since, over 10,000 students have been honored as Black Scholars and the program has expanded to include students from school districts in Genesee, Livingston, Ontario, Orleans, and Wayne counties. There are now over 60 high schools from the sixcounty area involved in the Black Scholars program.

Program eligibility established in 1980 remains much the same. Eligible students earning a B or higher cumulative grade point average are recognized by their respective school district. Final grades are certified by the school districts at the end of seven semesters, during the spring of the senior year. Black Scholars must be in a Regents or above curriculum.
