## Important Information To Know

### Accommodations

- An American Sign Language Interpreter will be present for graduation. Please contact us if your family has a need for an interpreter so we can seat them accordingly.
- Handicap accessible seating is available but limited. We ask that you use it accordingly.

### Caps/Gowns/Regalia

- **Caps and gowns will be distributed in the cafeteria on Wednesday, May 31st during all lunches, the day of Senior Parade.**
- The following regalia will be included with cap/gown:
  - Honor Cords (*overall unweighted 7<sup>th</sup> semester rank >90%*)
- **After May 31st, caps and gowns will be available in the HS Main Office Reception Area between 8am-3pm.**
- Caps are allowed to be decorated for graduation. All decorations and embellishments must be appropriate.
- The following regalia will be distributed on Awards Night, Tuesday, June 6th:
  - Magna Cum Laude Tassels (*overall unweighted 7<sup>th</sup> semester rank 94%-96.99%*)
  - Summa Cum Laude Tassels (*overall unweighted 7<sup>th</sup> semester rank >97%*)
  - Project Lead The Way Medals
- **After June 6th, regalia items will be available in the HS Main Office Reception Area between 8am-3pm**
- The following honor cords will be distributed by club advisors prior to graduation:
  - Business Honor Society, French Honor Society, National Honor Society, Spanish Honor Society, and Tri-M Honor Society.

### Concessions

- Food concessions will be open and available for purchase during the event.

### Diplomas

- Due to the early date of graduation, graduates will be receiving their diploma covers during graduation, NOT their actual diplomas.
- **Diplomas will be available for pick-up at the HS Main Office Reception Area Monday, June 26<sup>th</sup> - Thursday June 29<sup>th</sup> from 8am - 3pm.**  
**(Students can only pick up and sign for their own diploma!)**
- All financial obligations must be satisfied before receiving their diploma. Students will be notified of any outstanding obligations prior to this week.

## Parking

- Parking is available across the street from Innovative Field in the Kodak lot. Entry to Innovative Field will only be through the gates on "Main Street." Please follow directions from the parking attendants and the Rochester Police Department.
- Handicapped parking will also be available in the executive lot. A New York State handicapped parking pass is required and must be visible in your vehicle at all times.

## Rain Date

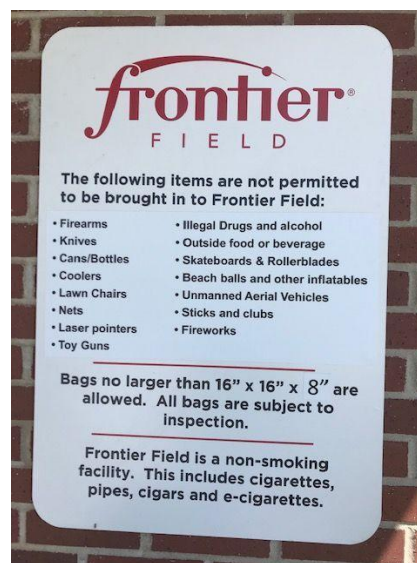
- In the event of inclement weather, the management of Innovative Field will determine if the ceremony needs to be postponed to Monday June 12, 2023 at 7:30pm.

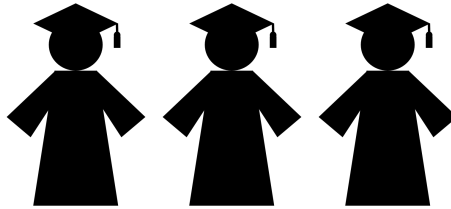
## Shoes

## Tickets & Seating

- Gates will open at 6:30pm. Tickets are not required and there will be open seating throughout the stadium. We would recommend holding a seat for the graduate as they may join you after the ceremony to view the fireworks.
- Handicap accessible seating is available along the main concourse at Frontier Field in multiples of 2. We cannot guarantee that the handicap accessible seating will be near your group so please plan accordingly.
- Graduation programs will be available at the entrances.
- For those families/friends that cannot attend, the event will be live streamed. The recorded program will also be available at a later date.
