Victor High School offers three “Concurrent Enrollment” opportunities where students have the potential to earn both high school and State University of New York (SUNY) college credit for courses taught here at the high school by Victor teachers:

- 1. Gemini classes**
- 2. Project Lead the Way classes**
- 3. AP classes**

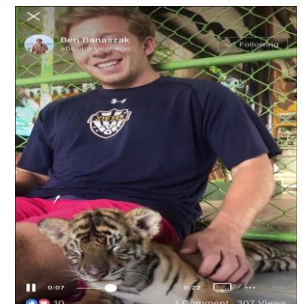
Why Choose to Register for Gemini?

- ◆ **\$\$\$:** It's the least expensive tuition you will ever pay for college credits @ \$5.00/credit hour!
- ◆ **Admissions:** College Admissions Reps consider successful experience with college level coursework important in the Admissions Application Review!
- ◆ **Advanced Status based upon credits earned:** Similar to the benefits of taking Algebra, Earth Science or Studio Art in 8th grade
 - ◆ Major course credits
 - ◆ General Elective credits
 - ◆ Advancing in coursework allows time to pursue a double major or minor
 - ◆ Priority Registration for classes
 - ◆ Early eligibility for Study Abroad, Research Opportunities, or Internships

What is the difference?

AP

- All students who are enrolled in an AP class are expected to take the AP Exam.
- Cost:
 - \$94.00 per AP exam due by Nov. 15th
 - Additional \$40 Late Fee if payment received by College Board after that date.

SUNY Gemini

- No College Level Exam required
- Your grade is simply your Final Average in the class at the end of this semester...No additional exam needed!
- Gemini cost:
 - \$15.00 fee for a 3 credit course
 - \$20.00 fee for a 4 credit course
 - Registration Day at Victor HS is September 26th-bring your forms and payment to the Cafeteria during all lunches
 - Deadline for Fall payment mailed to FLCC is Friday, October 4th

PLTW

- Students are eligible to take the RIT exam at the end of any PLTW course, if they have an 85% or better average each and every marking period.
- Students receive their score in June. Score of 6=C, 7=B, 8 and 9=A
- \$225 Payment is made directly to RIT
- Payment is due by November of the school year after you completed the course in order to have that grade posted to an RIT transcript

Which should you take?

AP/IB

SUNY/Gemini

Our Recommendation

- We recommend that you register to take **BOTH** the AP exam and Register for Gemini credit too so that you will have a back up plan just in case you do not score high enough on the AP Exam to receive credit.
- Many colleges and universities nationwide will award college credit for **BOTH** your AP score and your SUNY/FLCC Gemini credits
- You may have the potential to *double your credits* for one course!

How is college credit granted?

Credit will not be granted unless you do the following:

AP / IB

- It is your responsibility to contact College Board (for AP) or the IBO (for IB) to request your score reports to be sent to your college or university at the end of senior year.
- AP scores are generally available online at apcentral.collegeboard.org approximately 6-8 weeks after taking the exam.
- IB scores are available by contacting Mr. Dubash after July 4th.
- When you attend your college Orientation, you should also bring a copy of your scores to your meeting with your College Advisor to review your AP and IB Scores.
- Your advisor will determine which college requirements you have met and which courses you will still need to enroll in at college depending on:
 - What your AP Scores are
 - What your major is
 - What the college policy is for awarding credits

PLTW or Gemini

- It is your responsibility to request your transcript from RIT at www.rit.edu for your PLTW transcript
- It is your responsibility to request your transcript from FLCC at www.flcc.edu for Gemini coursework to be sent to your college or university at the end of senior year.
- When you meet with your college advisor at Orientation, they will determine if they will grant you credit depending on:
 - What your grades are
 - What your major is
 - What the college policy is for awarding credits

* Education Law, Section 6305 provides "The Chief Fiscal Officer of each county, as defined in Section 2.03 of the Local Finance Law, shall, upon application and approval of both of said parties, issue to any person desiring to enroll in a community college as a non-resident student, a certificate of residence showing that said person is a resident of said county. Such person shall, upon registration for each college year, file with the college such a certificate of residence. **SHOULD NOT EXCEED** Three (3) months prior to the first day of the college year, and such certificate of residence shall be valid for one year from date of issuance."
Education Law, Section 6301, paragraph 4, defines residence - a person who resides in the state for a period of at least one year and in the county, city, town, village or school district or county district, in conformity with the state of such person's registration in a community college, or for the purpose of Section 6305. Three Hundred Five of this chapter, in application for a certificate of residence.

** In the event that a person qualified as above for state residence, but has been a resident of two or more counties in the state during the six months immediately preceding his/her application for a certificate of residence pursuant to Section 6305, the Hundred Five of this chapter, the charges to the counties of residence shall be calculated among the several counties proportional to the number of months, or major fraction thereof, of residence in each county.
